



## **Anne BILLANT** (Piano - France)

Anne Billant was unanimously awarded a First Prize in piano and a First Prize in chamber music by the CNSMD in Paris. She is also a laureate of the Orléans 20th Century International Piano Competition. She works under the direction of Gabriel Tacchino and Catherine Collard.

As part of Radio France's concerts, she performs Jean-Etienne Marie's *Le Tombeau de Carillo* on a one-third tone piano with the composer and participates on the French radio station France Musique in the programs *Les Démons de Midi*, *En Blanc et Noir*, *Sur le Plateau*. She recorded a CD of French music with the violinist Jérôme Marchand.

Anne Billant performs regularly in France and abroad. She plays as soloist at the International Piano Festival of La Roque d'Anthéron and also with orchestra (concertos by Mozart, Beethoven, Schumann, Prokofiev).

For several years now, she has regularly accompanied singers on recital tours and participated in shows combining dance and theatre. She likes to play chamber music and has just recorded a performance together with an actor.

Holder of the French piano teaching diploma, she currently teaches at the Conservatoire du 9e arrondissement de Paris where she is also a referent teacher for students with disabilities. She trained in 2016 to teach piano to children with autism.
