



## **Gaspard Dehaene** (Piano - France)

When he premiered *Une page d'éphéméride* by Boulez at the age of 20, the French newspaper *Le Monde* greeted Gaspard Dehaene as "a young pianist with a racy explosiveness"...

Born in 1987, he has already had a brilliant career as a concert pianist, both as a soloist and as a chamber musician. Winner of the Pro Musicis 2015 Prize and Spedidam artist, many prestigious festivals invite him : Bagatelle, Orangerie de Sceaux, La Baule, Perros-Guirec, La Folle Journée de Nantes, La Roque d'Anthéron... After having performed in various cities in Europe and China, he made his debut in Japan in September 2017, before flying to New York on the invitation of the Guggenheim Museum. He played Liszt's *Piano Concerto N° 1* at the Philharmonie de Paris in January 2018.

His discography comprises a considerable number of albums and is warmly acclaimed by the press: "he keeps the listener on the edge of his seat with a deeply moving poetic sense", "lyricism, beautiful sound, a musical delight..."

With his secret and radiant nature, his passionate involvement touches the audience at each concert.
