Nadezhda Offroy-Sakovitch, born in Moscow, of French-Russian nationality, began the piano at the age of 6 at the Kaliningrad Regional Conservatory and obtained all his state diplomas at the Moscow Higher School of Music.

She was director of cultural projects, music and painting at the Centre d'Echanges Cultural and Scientific Centre of Moscow until 1990, between France and Russia.

Obtaining French nationality in 2000, she obtained a position as a piano teacher in the Hauts de France Region and in particular the Arras Conservatory.

She has extensive professional training and specialises in research young talents as part of her mission as Artistic Advisor to the festival "Les Pianos Folies" of Le Touquet-Paris-Plage since 2009.

Organizer of many Master-Classes with great pianists such as Brigitte Engerer, Mikhail Rudy, Nikolai Lugansky, she also participates as a member of the Jury at international competitions in Hungary and Russia.
